At the same time the suffering of the patients is emphasized by the frequently chronic character of their disease and by the need to undergo usually lengthy and physically demanding therapies, which are not exempt from collateral effects.

These are the reasons why Menarini believes deeply in the importance of giving practitioners an efficient means for the dissemination of scientific information, a tool with which they can exchange views and read up on the latest advances and discoveries in the field of autoimmune diseases.
